CONDITIONS OF PLAY 2026

PLAYER ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS

At the closing date for nominations, players must have played the majority of the 2025-26 season as a member of a Country Club (as defined by Bowls WA). If, during the season, a country player has played Men's Saturday or Women's Tuesday Metropolitan pennants, then they are ineligible to enter.

COMPETITION DATES AND FORMATS

Thursday 26th February 2026

TIME

- 9.00am for 9.30am start
- Trial end will commence at 9.15am

FORMAT

- 1 game of Fours, 2 bowls each – 13 ends
- 1 game of Split Pairs, 3 bowls each – 11 ends (other pair has lunch)
- 1 game of Split Pairs, 3 bowls each – non-continuous – 11 ends (remaining pair has lunch)
- 1 game of Fours, 2 bowls each – 13 ends

1-way roll-up for first game

No dead ends, re-spot the jack

Appropriate Bowls Australia approved clothing must be worn

ENTRY FEE

- \$160 per team (incl. GST)

MATCH DETERMINATION

WEATHER AFFECTED GAMES

If the game is called off due to extreme weather, 9 completed ends will constitute a game in the Fours, and 8 completed ends will constitute a game in the Pairs.

SECTIONAL PLAY

The winner of the day will be determined by the number of games won (3 points for a win, 1 point for a draw). If these are equal, then the winner will be determined by the highest number of shots up. If these are equal, then the winner will be determined by the 'number of shots for' divided by 'shots against' (Percentage %).
