

2ND DIVISION & UNDER MEN'S TRIPLES, PAIRS & SINGLES CONDITIONS OF PLAY 2023

PLAYER ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS

At the closing date for nominations, players must have played the majority of the 2022-23 season's Saturday Pennant games in 2nd Division or lower.

If a player only plays Midweek Pennants, then they must have played the majority of the 2022-23 season's Midweek Pennant games in 2nd Division or lower.

COUNTRY PLAYERS

Players may enter as long as they were not part of the 2021-22 Inter League Round Robin or have not been selected in the 2022-23 Inter League Round Robin.

The organising committee has the right to reject entries that may be in conflict with the spirit of the competition. Players may apply in writing to the organising committee for dispensation to the eligibility criteria under extreme circumstances.

COMPETITION DATES AND FORMATS

TRIPLES

Sectional Play – Monday 2nd January 2023

Knockout Play – Tuesday 3rd January 2023

TRIPLES FORMAT

- 2 bowls per player, played straight
- Sectional Play (4 players per section) followed by knockout
- Sectional Play shall be 13 ends
- Post sectional and semi-finals shall be 15 ends
- Final will be 17 ends

TRIPLES ENTRY FEE

- \$66 per team (incl. GST)

SINGLES

Sectional Play – Saturday 8th April 2023

Knockout Play – Monday 10th April 2023 (and Tuesday 11th April if required)

SINGLES FORMAT

- 4 bowls per player
- Sectional Play (3 players per section) followed by knockout
- Sectional and Post-sectional Play shall be 17-up
- Semi-finals and Final shall be 21-up

SINGLES MARKING

- All players will be expected to mark during the day's play
- Players that refuse to mark when asked may incur a fine

SINGLES ENTRY FEE

- \$22 per player (incl. GST)

PAIRS

Sectional Play – Sunday 9th April 2023

Knockout Play – Monday 10th April 2023 (and Tuesday 11th April if required)

PAIRS FORMAT

- 3 bowls per player, played straight
- Sectional Play (4 players per section) followed by knockout
- Sectional Play shall be 13 ends
- Post sectional and semi-finals shall be 15 ends
- Final will be 17 ends

PAIRS ENTRY FEE

- \$44 per team (incl. GST)

TIME OF MATCHES

- Players to report by 9.00am for a 9.30am start
- Trial ends will commence at 9.15am

MATCH DETERMINATION

SECTIONAL PLAY

The winner of a section will be determined by the number of games won (3 points for a win, 1 point for a draw). If these are equal, then the winner will be determined by the highest number of shots up. If these are equal, then the winner will be determined by the 'number of shots for' divided by 'shots against' (Percentage %).
