CONDITIONS OF PLAY 2025

PLAYER ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS

At the closing date for nominations, players must have played the majority of the 2024-25 season's Saturday Pennant games in 2nd Division or lower. If a player only plays Midweek Pennants, then they must have played the majority of the 2024-25 season's Midweek Pennant games in 2nd Division or lower.

COUNTRY PLAYERS

Players may enter as long as they were not part of the 2023-24 Inter League Round Robin or have not been selected in the 2024-25 Inter League Round Robin.

The organising committee has the right to reject entries that may be in conflict with the spirit of the competition. Players may apply in writing to the organising committee for dispensation to the eligibility criteria under extreme circumstances.

MATCH DETERMINATION

SECTIONAL PLAY

The winner of a section will be determined by the number of games won (3 points for a win, 1 point for a draw). If these are equal, then the winner will be determined by the highest number of shots up. If these are equal, then the winner will be determined by the 'number of shots for' divided by 'shots against' (Percentage %).

DRESS

Players must wear Bowls Australia approved attire.

TIME OF MATCHES

- Players to report by 9.00am for a 9.30am start
- Trial ends will commence at 9.15am

COMPETITION DATES AND FORMATS

SINGLES

Sectional Play + knockouts (TBA) – Saturday 19th April 2025

Knockout Play – Q/F, S/F & F – Monday 21st April 2025 (and Tuesday 22nd April if required)

SINGLES ENTRY FEE: \$25 per player (incl. GST)

SINGLES MARKING

- All players will be expected to mark during the day's play
- Players that refuse to mark when asked may incur a fine

SINGLES FORMAT

- 4 bowls per player
- 2-end roll up, each way
- Replay dead ends
- Sectional Play (3 players per section) followed by knockout
- Sectional and Post-sectional Play shall be 17-up
- Semi-finals and Final shall be 21-up

PAIRS

Sectional Play + Knockouts (TBA) – Saturday 20th April 2025

Knockout Play – Q/F, S/F & F – Monday 21st April 2025 (and Tuesday 22nd April if required)

PAIRS ENTRY FEE: \$50 per team (incl. GST)

PAIRS FORMAT

- 3 bowls per player, played straight
- 2-end roll up, each way
- Replay dead ends
- Sectional Play (4 pairs per section) followed by knockout
- Sectional Play shall be 13 ends
- Post sectional and semi-finals shall be 15 ends
- Final will be 17 ends
